## **The Bible Says That All Men Are Sinners**

Our sins have separated us from God.

*"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)*

## **God's Word Also Says That Sin Must Be Punished**

*"For the wages of sin is death..." (Romans 6:23b)*

Wages means payment. The payment of our sin is death and hell, separation from God forever. If we continue in our sin, we shall die without Christ and be without God forever.
